DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Vacuum the floor thoroughly. Mix one part concentrate to 21 parts cold water (6 oz. concentrate to one gallon of cold water).
- Pre-spray the carpet until fibers are moistened.
- Light agitation of the carpet with a carpet brush or rake will increase the cleaning efficiency. Let stand for 5 minutes before extracting.
- To extract, fill the extraction machine's reservoir with water and use the equipment according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Test the carpet with your hand to determine if additional extraction passes are needed.
- Allow the carpet to dry overnight before walking on it. Once the carpet is completely dry, vacuum it thoroughly.
